To exhort the church to the continuance of the Great Commission and Worldwide Evangelism by the leading of the Holy Spirit with the Word of God (The Bible) to the nations, tribes and peoples at such a time as this.

It is intended for the SEEK Forum Charter to provide some protocol guidance to assist The SEEK Forum 198 Nations representatives in the execution of their appointed functions as National Kingdom Representatives (NKR). Māori Initiatives Trust submits this treasured work for the extension of the Gospel of Good News to all mankind o te nga hau e wha, to the four corners of the Globe.

The SEEK Forum is an historic, 198 Nations world apostolic assembly, called to advance the Kingdom of God on Earth and Christs Church **"on, by, in, and through"** the Seven Gates marketplace of the nations. The assembly will comprise two nominated National Kingdom Representatives or "NKR" from each of 198 nations sitting on The SEEK Forum in of 10 CNG. Bi-annual international gatherings in person and or in virtual person on the Mana-Metaverse (Virtual immersive online gathering space) and or Zoom to be held as often as the NKR representatives feel to meet. The SEEK Forum is Spirit-Filled, born again, 5-Fold led, Bible believing, teaching and living council of Apostolic leaders serving their nation/s

We are presently actively seeking two National Kingdom Representatives (NKR) from each of the 198 nations and first nations peoples to sit on The SEEK Forum.

Mission: To promote the Great Commission (Matt. 28:19-21 NKJV) in prayer, intercession and praise with applied Biblical principles of Kingdom Living (Matt. 6:9-14,33) through the Seven Gate Market place (Rev. 17:9) with Spiritual Vocations (Daniel 1:20) as taught and demonstrated by Jesus Christ.

Chapter One:

Kawa – 7 Core Values



The following Kawa / 7 Core values were provided by Kaumatua Wikitoria TeWhata of Ngāpuhi, Ngāti Porou, and Dr. Winkie Pratney (D. Lit.) of Ngāti Tai iwi and Māori Initiatives Trust NZ.

The Trinity. That, the Trinity dwell over The SEEK Forum (TSF) assembly / Hui Taumata*. (God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit). Gen. 1:26; Luke 3:22; Gal. 5:22-23

King Jesus. That, Jesus Christ, our great redeemer and King of Kings preside over TSF. Rev. 19:16; John 3:16-18

Kingdom Come. That, His Kingdom come on Earth (a now but not yet), in and through the 198 Nations and all first nations, tangata whenua, native peoples of the land. Matt. 6:9-13, 33

Melchizedek Rangimarie Marae. That, all TSF assembly gatherings be held/hosted on Melchizedek Marae / Hui Taumata gathering space in person and/or in virtual person/s (online).

Stewardship. The stewards of Melchizedek Marae are to host all TSF assembly gatherings on Melchizedek Marae, promoting the fruit of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22-23); hosting new and returning visitors with a customary

formal welcome with Kai Karanga and Whaikorero on Melchizedek Marae, and/or MihiMihi for all visitors and existing representatives of TSF



The Nation State of Israel (Zion). The SEEK Forum affirms the place of Israel, as God's chosen national people, as declared in Genesis 28:13. In His divine will, God has designated Israel to be a conduit of His blessings to the entire world, as stated in Genesis 12:3. This is for His glory, as noted in Isaiah 43:7, and to serve as His witness to the nations, as mentioned in Isaiah 43:10. God's election of Israel for this unique relationship is irrevocable, as affirmed in Romans 11:28-29.

The World Prayer Flag

The bird is representative of the Holy Spirit contained of all the nations where the Bible has landed in 10 Cluster Nation Groups "CNG" colors. The ring is comprised of seven colors across the top representing the Seven common Gates of Humanity (Rev. 17:9). The remaining 10 colors on the bottom presents 10 CNG of 198 nations. The World Prayer Flag was first raised and blessed during the ASK 2024 global nations prayer summit at YWAM Kona Hawaii USA by Kaumatua Wikitoria Tewhata of Ngapuhi, Ngati Porou, Rabbi Yaakov Brown, Apostle Steve Hutana, Ps. Paul Childers, Prophetess late Margaret Asher and a cloud of witnesses.

Chapter Two:

Tikanga – Charter Principles



1. Sovereignty of God and Lordship of Jesus Christ.

We acknowledge that ultimate authority belongs to our Creator.

"The earth is the LORD'S, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein." Psalm 24:1. "...God...hath...given him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father." Phil. 2:9-11

We affirm that governance, justice, and societal order should align with God's Word. (Deut. 10:17; 1 Chron. 29:11-12; Psalm 33:6-12; Proverbs 16:33; Daniel 4:34-37; Matthew 28:18-20; 1 Timothy 6:13-16; Revelation 19:16)

1.1 True Religion.

As children of the living God, we reject idolatry and religious syncretism, choosing to worship Him in spirit and in truth, recognizing that He, our Creator, alone is worthy of our worship. (Deuteronomy 4:15-20; 6:13-16; Isa. 29:13-14; John 4:19-26; Acts 17:16-31; Colossians 2:6 - 3:4; Philippians 3:3; Revelation 14:6-7) We uphold the Deity of Jesus Christ.

1.2 Affirming Biblical Family Values.

The family is the cornerstone of society, reflecting God's covenantal love (Ephesians 5:25). TSF aspires to see and encourage nations to commit to policies that uphold biblical marriage, protection of children, and honour of elders.

We affirm that a biblically recognizable marriage can exist only between a man (human adult male) and a woman (human adult female). (Gen 1:27-28; 2:18-24; Psalms 127:3-5; Prov. 22:6; Matthew 19:3-6; 1 Timothy 5:8)

2. The Pursuit of Peace.

As ambassadors of peace for Christ having been given the ministry of reconciliation, we stand as peace makers in a fallen world upholding the righteousness of God in Christ. (Psalms 34:14; Isaiah 32:17; Proverbs 16:7; John 14:27; 2 Cor. 5:18-20; Philippians 4:4-7; Hebrews 12:14; 1 Timothy 2:1)

2.1 Peace as a Fundamental Right:

We affirm that peace is not a mere absence of war but a fundamental covenant right of every individual, community, tribe and nation.

2.2 From the Word of God, the pillars of Truth, Justice, Righteousness and Love stand. From this hang the Fruit of the Spirit. Galatians 5:22-23; Ps. 89:14; Philippians 4:7; John 1:1

2.3 Basic community infrastructure:

We advocate for Kingdom-inspired transformation in food security, education, healthcare, sanitation, housing, and freedom of faith. These are not privileges—they are basic human rights, along with access, to water, food and clothing and for every family, and community. Phil 4:19

2.4 National Gardens of Prayer:

TSF aspires to see established National Gardens of Prayer for prayer, praise, thanksgiving and worship across the nations, as places for believers in Jesus Christ to meet with God to prayerfully intercede for your nation's towns, villages, cities, regions, and Government. (Genesis 2:8; 3:8; 26:25; 2 Chronicles 7:11-17; Joel 2:17-19; Ezekiel 22:30; Matthew 6:6-13; Matthew 18:18-20)





3. Environmental Stewardship

We believe that humans as a species have been tasked with environmental stewardship by God.

Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. Then God

blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth." Genesis 1:26-28

And the LORD God took the man and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it. 2:15

The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD'S: but the earth hath he given to the children of men. Psalms 115:16

3.1 Custodians of Our Planet:

We acknowledge that peace cannot thrive amidst environmental degradation. We pledge to advocate for the protection of our national environmental ecosystems, safeguarding our unique biodiversity with ethically sustainable environmental practices and resources.

3.2 Transcending Borders for Conservation:

We aspire to collaborate across borders for improved sustainable and ethical trade practices in place of deforestation, pollution, and habitat destruction. Our forests, oceans, and skies know no boundaries; their care and well-being is our collective responsibility.

4. Righteousness and Justice

As ambassadors of peace for Christ having been given the ministry of reconciliation, we stand as peace makers in a fallen world upholding the righteousness of God in Christ.

(Psalms 34:14; Isaiah 32:17; Proverbs 16:7; John 14:27; 2 Cor. 5:18-20; Philippians 4:4-7; Hebrews 12:14; 1 Timothy 2:1)

4.1 But let justice run down like water, And righteousness like a mighty stream. Amos 5:24.

But Seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. Matt. 6:33

Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people.

Prov. 14:34

Let the heavens declare His righteousness, For God Himself is Judge. Ps. 50:6

4.2 Standing on Revealed Truth:

As sons and daughters of God, recipients of His Spirit of Truth Who helps us walk in accordance with God's Word, we seek to please our Heavenly Father by living lives of continual surrender to Him, recognizing that He is sovereign over all. We trust that God has plans and purposes for our lives, endeavouring to work with Him as He reveals His will to us, listening for His voice, seeking His counsel, and standing on His promises as He directs, aiming to uphold His revealed truth like a torch to lighten the path for those who walk in darkness. (Matthew 5:14-16) "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path." (Psalms 119:104)

Exodus 18:21; 1 Samuel 12:24; Psalms 15:1-2; Psalms 85:10; Psalms 89:14; Psalms 111:7-8; Proverbs 20:28; Proverbs 21:28; Proverbs 29:14; John 1:1-9; John 1:17; John 3:20-21; John 8:12; John 10:27; John 16:13; Romans 1:18; 2 Corinthians 4:1-6





5. Cooperation and Solidarity.

5.1 Cooperation and Global Unity:

TSF affirm collaboration with the global Body of Christ to advance biblically based Kingdom living principles across nations. (John 17:21; Ephesians 4:1-6).

5.2 United in Purpose:

TSF shall endeavour to strengthen international institutions, recognizing that God's Kingdom on Earth in and through the nations requires belief, unity, action and cooperation alongside such international bodies as; The Ecclesia

(Global Body of Christ), all regional bodies, and civil society organizations.

5.3 Solidarity in Times of Crisis:

When disaster strikes – natural calamities, pandemics, or humanitarian emergencies – we stand ready to unite in prayer and to extend aid and compassion as the LORD directs and enables us. Ps. 46:

6. SEEK Forum Membership.

6.1 Membership guidelines:

Membership in The SEEK Forum is open to individuals of all nations* that are willing to uphold this Charter. Admission requires prayerful discernment, sponsorship, and a two-year provisional period prior to full membership, ensuring alignment with Kingdom values.

* that have passed the filters defining what constitutes a "nation" for the purposes of "Ask of Him" (created by Maori Initiatives), namely:

1. A Unique Flag.
2. Supreme Jurisdiction Over Defined Geopolitical Territory
3. A Population of 1,000+ Inhabiting the Defined Geopolitical Territory It Has Supreme Jurisdiction Over.
4. A Testimony of the Word of God Coming to Them / Landing On Their Shores.

6.2 TSF Admission and election of NKR:

Administration and all operations of TSF to be officiated/run by Maori Initiatives trust NZ.

Election of all sponsored / submitted NKR candidates to TSF to be prayerfully, discerningly chosen by Māori Initiatives Trust NZ in consultation with the Apostolic Advisory on a "as and when" needed basis. To become full National Kingdom Representative Member of The SEEK FORUM. The following steps are to be observed in full.

6.3 Applicants/Candidates:

By referral to TSF assembly must be sponsored by either a Maori Initiatives core team member, an Apostolic Advisory member or National Kingdom Representative "NKR" on the SEEK Forum. A quorum of no less than 20 NKR Assembly members to vote to accept provisional members. Where a majority vote is reached the applicant is made a "provisional NKR member" on the TSF.

6.4 Provisional Member:

Each successful applicant to be given SEEK Forum provisional membership for a period of no less than TWO YEARS. Note, National applicants may be replaced over this time subject to meeting the requirements of applicants.

6.5 Full Membership:

Provisional SEEK Forum assembly members to be inducted full membership at the successful completion of their TWO-YEAR provisional period and the final endorsement vote of TSF Assembly.





7. The Seven Kingdom Gates | Spiritual Vocations.

TSF support the advancing of the Gospel through the Seven Gates – Government, Family, True Religion, Education, Business & Commerce, Media, and Arts & Entertainment – mobilizing apostolic action (Revelation 17:9).

The Gate of Government,

The Gate of Family

The Gate of True Religion

The Gate of Education

The Gate of Business & Commerce

The Gate of Media

The Gate of Arts and Entertainment

7.1 TSF meeting Hosts:

TSF Hosts (Kaitiaki), Maori Initiatives Trust NZ kaitiaki / stewards / moderators to host all SEEK Forum gatherings.

7.2 TSF meeting location:

All TSF assembly gatherings/meetings are to be held on Melchizedek Marae in person or in virtual person (online)

8. The Hui Taumata. (Assembly)

8.1 TSF Hui Taumata Assembly to be composed of. Sponsored initiate national assembly representatives. Two provisional member national kingdom representatives from each nation.

Two full member national kingdom representatives from each nation. Maori Initiatives Kaitiaki Stewards to have Full membership status for “proxy” advocate of all Tangata whenua, First nations, Aboriginal and Native people/s of the land.

8.2 The Hui Taumata (Assembly) may discuss any questions or any matters within the scope of the present Charter or relating to the powers and functions of the Seven Kingdom Gates provided for in the

present Charter and, except as provided in Article 11.2, may submit proposals to the members of the SEEK FORUM on any such questions or matters arising.

9. The Apostolic Advisory.

9.1 TSF Apostolic Advisory is comprised of number of Apostles appointed, endorsed by Maori Initiatives Trust with longstanding recognised Apostleship calling. The Apostolic advisory primary responsibility is to. When called upon, provide guidance to the SEEK Forum assembly and NKR,s for the promotion of Kingdom living Mission through the Seven Gates with prophetic action by the Word of God and leading of the Holy Spirit.

9.2 The Apostolic advisory shall act in accordance with the Spirit (Wairua) of the TSF Charter and vision and submit to Maori Initiatives Trust who shall be responsible for prayerful addition, removal and replacement of Apostolic advisory members when required.

10. Settlement of Disputes.

TSF shall ensure that all parties to a dispute likely to. Endanger the maintenance of international peace and security.

10.1 Adversely impact on The Kingdom Mission work or the 7 Gates operations.

10.2 Contravene the Spirit of unity of the Assembly.

10.3 Openly oppose the tenants of The SEEK Charter.

10.4 Stand in open rebellion to the Word of God. The Seek Forum to provide peaceful and prayerful reconciliation on Melchizedek Rangimarie Marae with guidance of its custodians in accordance with 2 Cor. 5:18 (The ministry of reconciliation) and or Matt. 18.





10.5 Where no peaceful resolution attainable. TSF stewards are empowered upon witness of Māori Initiatives Trust with witness from TSF assembly to, remove a NKR member from the TSF upon where no other recourse is available.

10.6 In the unfortunate event a representative's membership needs, be revoked The TSF representatives must attain a unanimous witness where possible. A suitable replacement/s representative/s to be prayerfully sought.

11. Amendments.

Any changes to this Charter require a two-thirds vote of the SEEK Forum Assembly, subject to alignment with the seven core principles (Kawa) and protocols (Tikanga) of Maori Initiatives. Maori Initiatives Trust NZ, as steward, reserves the right to safeguard these foundations in good faith.

11.1 Maori Initiatives Trust Stewards of The SEEK Forum - Hui Taumata may rescind any such submitted proposals and or votes of The SEEK Forum as deemed necessary to preserve and uphold in good faith the SEEK Forums core principles and protocols of 10.2.1 and 10.2.2.

12. The Great Commission

In the light of Matthew 28:19–20, this charter calls every nation to embrace the mission of discipling nations, teaching Kingdom principles, and living out Christ's example.

Māori whanaungatanga emphasizes relational discipleship – building communities that reflect God's love and unity across cultures.

Micah 4:1-2; 2 Timothy 2:2; Colossians 3:16-17



Chapter Three: The 7 Gates Declaration



The Seven Gates (Rev. 17:9)

"Seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you." (Matthew 6:33)

The Seven Gate Declaration is not a policy; it is a faith expectant prayer, a covenant of trust, not control. We invite every nation, tribe, and tongue to stand in the gap as part of the Body of Christ in your own nation to uphold the righteousness and justice of God over each of the Seven Gates of your nation.

Preamble:

In holy reverence to our Creator God the Father, God the Son (Yeshua Hamashiach), and God the Holy Spirit, Māori Initiatives Trust NZ, as the stewards of The SEEK Forum, hereby decree in faith this covenantal (Kawanata) guide for the 198 nations, National Kingdom Representatives (NKR) and all Tangata Whenua (first nations peoples of the land). Rooted in the teachings of Jesus Christ and the prophetic call to Kingdom living, this Declaration affirms the Seven Gates (Waharoa) as domains through which Wisdom, righteousness, justice, Kingdom living and peace flow. May the Word of God go forth, fashioning the building blocks of Ethics and Values upon the Chief Cornerstone on which hang the 7 Gates, each uniquely forged according to function with the intent to reflect the

righteousness and justice of the King of Glory, the Lord strong and mighty... Yahweh.

(Amos 5:24; Pro. 14:34; Eph. 2:20; Isa. 9:6, 56:1, 62:2; Ps. 24:8, 33:12 NKJV).

We acknowledge the spiritual authority of Psalm 110:4 – the eternal priesthood of Christ – and the apostolic mandate of 1 Pet. 2:9 and Revelation 5:10: "... [You {Lamb of God}] have made us kings and priests to our God; And we shall reign on the earth." This reign is not imperial; it is relational, redemptive, and Holy Spirit-led. A Kingdom Living Church... a Kingdom Living Nation... A Kingdom Living People

Gate 1: Government – Te Tatau Kāwanatanga

"Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven." (Matthew 6:10)

Reflection:

The Government is not merely a structure; it is a God Ordained Institute. It is there to serve and protect the people of the Land, To over sea their countries resources, economic growth. Leaders should govern with wisdom, discernment, humility and honesty. They should be guided by Prayer to obtain the leading of the Holy Spirit. They should listen to the concerns and needs of their Nation. (Prov. 8 and 9; Gal. 5:22-23) Leaders should be aware that they are stewards with a higher calling.

Prayer Point:

We pray for those leading in our government, throughout Our Nation both National and Local Authority's. That their eyes will be enlightened to know you, that they may see from your perspective. So that they can make decisions that are in line with your Will.

We Pray that our government leaders, Will know the fear of the Lord So that they will respect position they have been assigned.

We ask that you increase within our Nation Godly Bold Leaders, to rise in prominent positions of Authority, that they will recognise your perfect will and will endeavour to achieve it.

We stand against perverse and proud

spirits, rendering them ineffective against Leaders in our Government.

Declaration:

Lord Jesus, We declare that you are Lord over _____ we invite you Holy Spirit to influence the hearts within our government. We declare that the light of your truth will dispel any darkness and expose any lies.

Action Point:

Encourage the National Kingdom Representatives (NKR's) serving on The SEEK Forum to initiate national prayer roundtable gatherings with civic leaders, embedding karakia (prayer) and the scriptures into their nations' political policies; in addition, providing wise council on how to implement Biblical principles for Kingdom Living.

Tikanga Māori – Kingdom Dynamics:

Affirms Rangatiratanga (chiefly leadership) as a sacred trust, where people in authority are held to higher standards

Supporting Bible Verses:

Proverbs 28:2 (NKJV)

Because of the transgression of a land, many are its princes;

But by a man of understanding and knowledge Right will be prolonged.

Titus 3:1 (NKJV)

Remind them to be subject to rulers and authorities, to obey, to be ready for every good work,

Isaiah 9:6-7





Gate 2: Family – Te Tatau Whānau

Now Adam knew Eve his wife, and she conceived and bore Cain, and said, “I have acquired a man from the Lord.” Then she bore again, this time his brother Abel. (Genesis 4:1-2a)

Reflection:

Family is the fundamental building block of all society. Husband, wife, father, mother, son, daughter, brother, sister...everyone is connected to someone. The ones that we connect to help identify us within society.

Declaration:

We decree and declare that our nation
o f

shall uphold the sanctity of marriage, the dignity of parenting, the protection of children and the honour of grandparents. We pray for our nation to make family restoration priority through good, godly policy, proactive prayer, and cultural renewal. We agree to celebrate often the place of family, praying God’s continued blessings, protection and salvation over our Tamariki and mokopuna (children and grandchildren).

Prayer Point:

Holy Spirit, breathe life into broken homes. Restore fathers, mothers, and children into Your design of love and honour.

Action Point:

Establish Family Blessing Days across the nation, where communities gather to speak life, pray, and honour whakapapa (family lineage taught by the elders).

Prayer Point:

Lord, sanctify our schools and universities. Let Your Spirit guide every teacher, student, and curriculum!

Action Point:

Develop cross-cultural learning exchanges between indigenous and European educators and their training centres.

Tikanga Māori – Kingdom Dynamics:

Affirming the value of Maturangatanganga – Knowledge. Some knowledge is tapu (sacred) and some knowledge is noa (common) passed down from generation to generation. In Māori culture there was no alphabet. Knowledge is passed through storytelling /learning (Wananga), lullabies (Whakatauki) and singing (Waiata).

Supporting Bible Verses:

Deuteronomy 6:6–7

And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.

Gate 4: True Religion – Te Tatau Whakapono Tūturu

Action Point:

Facilitate local, regional, intertribal, and international prayer and praise gatherings that honour biblical truth and celebrate Christ through culture.

Tikanga Māori – Kingdom Dynamics:

Affirms Wairuatanga, the spiritual essence of all things, as central to faith and life. In Māori culture the spiritual realm is always present, a part of our holistic way of seeing and being.

Supporting Verses:

John 3:16

16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

Matt. 28:19-20

19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Amen.

Gate 5: Business & Commerce - Te Tatau Pakihi me te Tauhokohoko

We decree over all businesses to; be profitable tools for restorative, thriving communities of national, regional and local business owners, managers and workers. We denounce in Jesus' name, any demonic influences of corrupt business and commerce practices over our nation of

We declare Kingdom Economic out pouring over our commercial and industry districts, lands, resources and knowledge from exploitation and manipulation.

Prayer Point:

Lord, bless the hands of those who do business and trade with integrity. Let wealth be used to enhance the people and the land, not harm. Let the sheeves (profits) of business be given to those in need like the widows, orphans and homeless.

Action Point:

Support National and local indigenous and Kingdom living entrepreneurs and businesses, networks that operate with integrity and accountability.

Tikanga Māori – Kingdom Dynamics:

Affirms manaakitanga (the generous care of others) as an applied Kingdom business ethic.

Supporting Scriptures:

Exodus 22:25

If you lend money to any of My people who are poor among you, you shall not be like a moneylender to him; you shall not charge him interest.

Deuteronomy 23:19

You shall not charge interest to your brother—interest on money or food or anything that is lent out at interest.


